Let's use this holiday to reduce screen time, build healthy habits, revise learning through play, and grow closer as a family!

Holiday Activities

01. Good Habits, SEL & Daily Routine

Start the day with the Gayatri Mantra. Every morning after waking up, your child should say "Good Morning," and before sleeping, say "Good Night."
Small ritual, big impact!

02. Mirror Affirmation

Each morning, look in the mirror together and say:
"I am happy. I am strong. My name is _____. I am ____ years old."

03. Sound of the Day

Pick one sound each day (like /s/, /a/, /t/). Find 3 things at home that begin with that sound and say them aloud!

04. Word of the Day

Choose one tricky word (I, HE, THE) each day. Spot it in books or use it in a sentence!

05. Number of the Day

Pick a number (1, 2, 3...). Find that many objects, write the number, and use it in a sentence.
Example: I have two hands.

06. Daily Independence Star

Encourage your child to do one task independently each day – brushing teeth, wearing shoes, packing bag, etc.
Reward them with a small "Independence Star." This builds confidence – what LKG is all about!

07. Emotion Game (Dumb Charades)

Take turns acting out feelings (happy, sad, angry, excited, proud) without speaking while others guess! So much fun! ☐

08. Big or Small

Compare objects at home — utensils, fruits, jars, etc. — to understand the concepts of big and small!

09. My Plant Friend

Choose a plant at home as your child's very own "plant friend." Water it daily, clean its leaves, and greet it!

Take before-and-after pictures to observe growth. Also encourage feeding birds and caring for nature!

10. Visit New Places & Connect with Family

Visit a new place once a week. Encourage your child to call relatives, greet them, ask how they are, and end with "I love you."

This builds strong family bonds and speaking skills!
