TEACHING POSTS

PRIMARY TEACHER (PRT):

Mandatory Qualifications :

- (a) A Bachelor's Degree from any University recognised by the Govt. of India/UGC/AICTE, with a minimum marks of 50 percent in the aggregate.
- (b) A Bachelor of Education Degree or its equivalent from a college/university recognised by Govt. of India/AICTE/UGC/National Council of Teachers Education, with a minimum marks of 50% in the aggregate.
- (c) Should be in the age group of 21 to 50 years as on 01 July of the academic year in which the post is being filled.
- (d) Women candidates and physically challenged candidates will be given age relaxation upto a maximum of five years.
- (e) Ex-servicemen candidates who have put in not less than six months of continuous service in the Army, Navy or the Air Force shall be allowed to deduct the period of such service from their actual age and if the resultant age does not exceed the maximum age limit prescribed for the post by more than three years, they shall be deemed to have satisfied the condition regarding age limit. Such ex-servicemen candidates, if selected for the post, will also retire from the School as per rules of the Society.
- (f) Candidates with at least two years continuous service as a PGT/TGT or three years as a PRT in any Air Force School but presently not working in an Air Force School, will be given age relaxation upto the extent of such service rendered in Air Force School.
- (g) Should be able to read, write and communicate fluently in English and Hindi.

Desirable Qualifications :

- (h) Knowledge of computer applications, especially MS Office.
- (j) Ability to read/write/communicate in Hindi.

TRAINED GRADUATE TEACHERS (TGTs)

Mandatory Qualifications

A Masters or a Bachelor's Degree from any University recognised by the Govt. of India/UGC/AICTE with a minimum marks of 50 percent in the subject and 50 percent in the aggregate, including electives and languages, in the combination of subjects as under:-

- (a) **TGT (English):-** English as an elective subject at Degree level.
- (b) **TGT (Science):-** Botany, Zoology and Chemistry (All three subjects should have been studied).
- (c) **TGT (Social Studies):-** Any two out of History, Geography, Economics or Political Science, of which one must be History or Geography.
- (d) **TGT (Drawing):-** Diploma in Drawing and painting/Sculpture/Graphic Art from any Govt. recognized institution **OR** Four years' Diploma in Fine Arts and Crafts from Viswa Bharati, Shanti Niketan **OR** Diploma in Fine Arts from Govt. School of Arts and Crafts, Patna **OR** M.A. in Drawing and Painting from Agra University, Agra **OR** Degree/Diploma in Fine Arts from Regional Colleges of Education.
- (e) **TGT (Counsellor Cum Special Educator) :-** Diploma in Counselling from a recognized University or BA/B.Sc. Psychology with Educational Psychology / Counselling Psychology from a recognized University or M.A/M.Sc. in Counselling Psychology or M.A/M.Sc. Psychology with Counseling Psychology as specialisation or M.A/M.Sc. in Applied Psychology with Counselling Psychology from a recognized University. **Desirable Qualification :** Candidates holding Degree / Diploma in special education in addition to the abovementioned QRs shall be given preference.

Other Criteria :

- (f) Should be in the age group of 21 to 50 years as on 01 July of the academic year.
- (g) Women candidates and physically challenged candidates will be given age relaxation upto a maximum of five years.

(h) Ex-servicemen candidates who have put in not less than six months of continuous service in the Army, Navy or the Air Force shall be allowed to deduct the period of such service from their actual age and if the resultant age does not exceed the maximum age limit prescribed for the post by more than three years, they shall be deemed to have satisfied the condition regarding age limit. Such ex-servicemen candidates, if selected for the post, will also retire from the School as per rules of the Society.

(j) Candidates with only two years continuous service in any Air Force School but presently not working in an Air Force School, will be given age relaxation upto the extent of such service rendered in Air Force School, subject to maximum of two years. Serving staff of the School who apply for the post will also be so eligible.

(k) Should be able to read, write and communicate fluently in English and Hindi.

POST – GRADUATE TEACHERS (PGTs)

Mandatory Qualifications.

A Masters degree from any University recognised by the Govt. of India/UGC/AICTE with a minimum aggregate marks of 50% Marks in the subject and 50 %t in the aggregate:-

(a) **PGT (Computer) :** B.E or B. Tech (Comp Sc/IT) or an equivalent degree or diploma from an institution/University recognised by the Govt. of India, **OR** B.E. or B. Tech (any stream) and Post Graduate Diploma in Computers from any recognized University **OR** M.Sc. (Computer Science)/ MCA or equivalent from a recognized University **OR** B. Sc. (Computer Science)/ BCA or equivalent and Post Graduate degree in any subject from recognized University **OR** Post Graduate Diploma in Computer and Post Graduate degree in any subject from a recognized University **OR** B' or 'C' Level from DOEACC

(b) **PGT (Economics):** P.G in Economics / Applied Economics /Business Economics with Minimum 50% Marks.

(c) **PGT (Political Sc.):** P.G in Political Science with minimum 50% Marks.

- (d) **PGT (English):** A Master degree in English from University recognized by the Govt of India / UGC / AICTE with a Minimum 50% Marks in aggregate.

Other Criteria :

- (f) Should be in the age group of 21 to 50 years as on 01 July of the academic year.
- (g) Women candidates and physically challenged candidates will be given age relaxation upto a maximum of five years.
- (h) Ex-servicemen candidates who have put in not less than six months of continuous service in the Army, Navy or the Air Force shall be allowed to deduct the period of such service from their actual age and if the resultant age does not exceed the maximum age limit prescribed for the post by more than three years, they shall be deemed to have satisfied the condition regarding age limit. Such ex-servicemen candidates, if selected for the post, will also retire from the School as per rules of the Society.
- (j) Candidates with only two years continuous service in any Air Force School but presently not working in an Air Force School, will be given age relaxation upto the extent of such service rendered in Air Force School, subject to maximum of two years. Serving staff of the School who apply for the post will also be so eligible.
- (k) Should be able to read, write and communicate fluently in English and Hindi.

NON – TEACHING POSTS (AFSSS)

(a) LIBRARIAN :

- (i) University degree in Library Science or graduate with one year diploma in Library Science from a Govt. recognised institution.
- (ii) Should be in the age group of 25 to 50 years as on 01 July of the academic year in which the post is being filled.
- (iii) Women candidates and physically challenged candidates will be given age relaxation upto a maximum of five years.

(iv) Ex-servicemen candidates who have put in not less than six months of continuous service in the Army, Navy or the Air Force shall be allowed to deduct the period of such service from their actual age and if the resultant age does not exceed the maximum age limit prescribed for the post by more than three years, they shall be deemed to have satisfied the condition regarding age limit. Such ex-servicemen candidates, if selected for the post, will also retire from the School as per rules of the Society.

(v) Candidates with at least two years continuous service in any Air Force School but presently not working in an Air Force School, will be given age relaxation upto the extent of such service rendered in Air Force School, subject to a maximum of two years. Serving staff of the School who apply for the post will also be eligible for the same.

(vi) Should be able to read, write and communicate fluently in English and Hindi.

(vii) Basic knowledge of computer applications, especially MS Office.

(b) LAB ATTENDANT :

(i) 10+2 with Science.

(ii) Should be in the age group of 21 to 50 years as on 01 July of the academic year in which the post is being filled.

(iii) Women candidates and physically challenged candidates will be given age relaxation upto a maximum of five years.

(iv) Ex-servicemen candidates who have put in not less than six months of continuous service in the Army, Navy or the Air Force shall be allowed to deduct the period of such service from their actual age and if the resultant age does not exceed the maximum age limit prescribed for the post by more than three years, they shall be deemed to have satisfied the condition regarding age limit. Such ex-servicemen candidates, if selected for the post, will also retire from the School as per rules of the Society.

(v) Candidates with at least two years continuous service in any Air Force School as Lab Assistant to be given age relaxation upto the extent of such service rendered in Air Force School. Serving staff of the school who apply for the post who will apply for the post will also be eligible for the same.

(vi) Should be able to read, write and communicate fluently in English and Hindi.

(C) ACCOUNTS ASSISTANT :

(i) B Com from a Govt. recognised University with knowledge of accounts and book-keeping.

(ii) Typing speed of at least 40 wpm in English.

(iii) Basic knowledge of computer applications, especially MS Office.

(iv) Should be in the age group of 25 to 50 years as on 01 July of the academic year in which the post is being filled.

(v) Women candidates and physically challenged candidates will be given age relaxation upto a maximum of five years.

(vi) Ex-servicemen candidates who have put in not less than six months of continuous service in the Army, Navy or the Air Force shall be allowed to deduct the period of such service from their actual age and if the resultant age does not exceed the maximum age limit prescribed for the post by more than three years, they shall be deemed to have satisfied the condition regarding age limit. Such ex-servicemen candidates, if selected for the post, will also retire from the School as per rules of the Society.

(vii) Candidates with at least two years continuous service in any Air Force School but presently not working in an Air Force School, will be given age relaxation upto the extent of such service rendered in Air Force School, subject to a maximum of two years. Serving staff of the School who apply for the post will also be eligible for the same.

(viii) Should be able to read, write and communicate fluently in English and Hindi.
